Notnim Koach - Profile

Background:

Notnim Koach has worked over the last eight years to improve the lives of children with various levels of retardation and autism.

The organization has set a goal to make it easier for children to cope with their limitations and to provide families with the tools, strength and ability to cope the challenges they face.

Work Environment:

Notnim Koach works all over Israel, in particular in the "Merkaz" area, in and around Petah Tikva, Bnei Brak, Elad, Ramat Gan and slightly southwards to the Lachish and Ashdod regions. Once a year on Shabbat HaGadol (the shabbat before Pesach), a huge weekend getaway is held for hundreds of children from all over the country.

Our Activists:

We have hundreds of activists, mainly girls and women. Are all volunteers and receive training from Notnim Koach's professional staff and are active in the organization's activities.

Types of activity:

Our activities function on several levels:

1. Volunteers mentor and accompany individual children.

Mentors are assigned to specific children, gain their trust and accompany them throughout the year. The mentors are constantly in touch, and track each child's integration into their environment.

2. A daily afternoon day-care center operating throughout the week.

The center houses a play area and games yard which are equipped with specially-adapted facilities suitable for use by children with special needs, individual treatment rooms, a dining room, and relaxation rooms.

Each child attending the facility is accompanied by a personal volunteer who offers dedicated, professional care to work maximize the children's potential with their limits.

3. Weekend Getaways - once a month for about 40 special children.

Children leave their homes for the entire weekend for a special experience, with each child accompanied by their individual mentor. During these weekends, the children relax as they take a break from their regular routine and take part in a wide range of activities and experiences. The camps are accompanied by a medical team, medics and logistics personnel. The children's families testify that these Shabbat experiences help parents gather strength, help other children at home express themselves, and give the entire family unit extra strength and the ability to continue.

4. Summer Camps and Holiday Activities.

At special times of the year, children take part in a number of days packed with attractions, fun experiences and activities which allow them to relax and give their parents time to enjoy a vacation with their other children.

These camps require special logistics and very careful preparation in order to appropriately cater for each child according to his / her needs and limitations.

5. The organization's professional staff maintains an open channel with the families and receives updates on each child's situation and their particular needs. In cases where intervention or assistance is required of the organization, it is given immediately as necessary.
